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The trendelenburg gait
is caused by a
unilateral weakness of
the hip abductors,
mostly the gluteal
musculature. This
weakness could be due
to superior gluteal
nerve damage or in 5th
lumbar spine lesion.

This condition makes it
difficult to support the
body's weight on the
affected side. During
normal gait, both lower
limbs bear half of the
body weight is some
part of stance phase.

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
