Despite an often unfair reputation as being less popular, less successful, or less refined than their bona-fide Broadway counterparts, Off Broadway musicals deserve their share of critical acclaim and study. Infused with R&B sounds and a universal message, it is fair to say that, without Pippin, there is no *Spring Awakening*, *Dear Evan Hansen*, or even *Hamilton*.
