Nell'ebook si ripropone il testo di La Leda senza cigno raccolto nelle Prose di romanzi, edizione diretta da Ezio Raimondi, vol. II, a cura di Niva Lorenzini, "I Meridiani", Mondadori, Milano 1988. Gli apparati informativi riproducono quelli pubblicati nell'edizione dei "Meridiani"; la Cronologia riproduce quella pubblicata nel primo tomo delle Prose di ricerca (a cura di Annamaria Andreoli e Giorgio Zanetti, "I Meridiani", Mondadori, Milano 2005). Espressione di un profondo bisogno di rinnovamento esistenziale e intellettuale, questa prosa, composta mentre d'Annunzio è in esilio in Francia e pubblicata nel 1916 presso Treves, ha caratteri di novità sia dal punto di vista strutturale che ideologico. Difficilmente ascrivibile alla categoria-romanzo, La Leda è uno dei pochi testi dannunziani che si affida invece che al consueto protagonismo autobiografico a una narrazione differita: la vicenda dell'avventuriera dall'emblematica bellezza è infatti affidata alla voce di un misterioso alter ego, Desiderio Moriar. L'ambientazione in una Landa desolata e spettrale, la scrittura musicale che procede più per illuminazioni che seguendo un vero intreccio narrativo, rendono questa prova del d'Annunzio "notturno" ancora parzialmente irrisolta tra espedienti di racconto e volontà di auscultazione interiore.
